## **FROM THE PRO: Jeff Copeland**

The big news this month, and next, is our club's continuing golf events. For golf, this is the busiest time of the year, with our premiere event being "The Member/Guest Tournament" on the 18<sup>th</sup> thru the 20<sup>th</sup>. (See below for a full list of events.) The entry fee is \$400 per team and it is limited to the first 54 teams with a deadline to sign-up of July 15<sup>th</sup>. Complete details of the tournament are available in The Golf Shop. During the tournament, the course will be closed Friday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. The course and range will be closed all day on Saturday and closed Sunday morning until completion of the event, which should be around 3 p.m. (weather permitting).

## **JUNIOR CLINICS:**

The junior clinics continue on every Tuesday at new times. The 8 years old and up clinic will be from 9:30 to 10:30 a.m. and the 5-7 year old clinic is from 10:40 to 11:10 a.m. Guests are welcome to attend.

Private one on one lessons are also available at your convenience.

## **CLUB GOLF EVENTS:**

Club Scramble every Thursday afternoon at 5:30 p.m. Call by 4:45 to sign up. The cost is \$20 and includes cart, bring a guest for \$10 more. Must be at least 18 years old.

Couples Scramble on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Fridays at 5:30 p.m. Call by 4:45 to sign up. \$30 per couple and includes cart, bring a guest for \$10 more. Join us on June 25<sup>th</sup> for the Friday night dinners afterward.

Senior Monthly – Wed. 9<sup>th</sup> – 8 a.m. shotgun start

Junior Club Championship – Monday July 14<sup>th</sup> – Tee times start at noon. The age divisions are 5 to 6 (play 4 holes), 7 to 8 (play 6 holes), 9 to 10 (9 holes), 11 to 12 (9 holes), 13 to 14 (18 holes), and 15 to 17 (18 holes).

Member-Guest Tournament – July 18<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup> – Limited to the first 56 Teams. The cost will be \$400 per team with full details of this fun event in The Golf Shop.

Senior Club Championship – August 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> – Sign up in the Golf Shop – Pre-Flighted by age divisions.

Men's Club Championship – August 22<sup>nd</sup> - 24<sup>th</sup> – Men with handicap indexes of 9.9 or less must play Friday thru Sunday. All others play only Saturday and Sunday.
