Also, due to the flood in September, we had to reschedule a couple of events and move them to this month. Please see below for these dates and times. I apologize for any inconvenience that these events may cause you and I appreciate your patience.

## JUNIOR CLINICS:

These will continue every Tuesday through October from 4 to 5 p.m. for 8 years and up. The 5 to 7 year-olds will be from 5:10 to 5:40.

## UPCOMING EVENTS:

**The Club Scramble** every Thursday is over for the year. We'll crank it back up next April.

**Senior Club Championship** – Saturday & Sunday October 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> – Sign up in the Golf Shop – Pre-Flighted by age divisions of 50 to 64 (play the white tees) and 65 & up (play the gold tees) and if enough play we'll have flights within the age divisions. Entry Fee is \$50. Tee times will begin at 8 a.m. both days. Deadline to sign-up is October 1<sup>st</sup>. This is a rescheduled date because of the flood from last month. **Course is open for play both before 7:30 a.m. and after 10 a.m. each day.**

**Sertoma Private Outing** – Friday October 9<sup>th</sup> – This is a make-up date for this event due to the flood from last month. 8 a.m. shotgun start and the course is closed until about 12:30 p.m.

**Private Outing** – Monday the 12<sup>th</sup> – Course is closed for Spain Park Athletic Fund Raiser.

**Senior Monthly** – Wed. 14<sup>th</sup> – 8 a.m. shotgun start. Course is open for regular play
