GOLF CLINICS:

Juniors:

Starting Tuesday March 16th after school from 4 to 5 p.m., our junior clinics will start again for 8 year-olds and up and continue every Tuesday until further notice. The cost is \$10 for members and \$15 for guests. The 5 to 7 year old clinic will follow at 5:10 to 5:40 and the cost is \$7 for members and \$10 for guests. Fundamentals and golf etiquette will be the main focus with occasional playing time on the course. Proper attire is required (no gym shorts or tee shirts).

Ladies:

There is a ladies golf clinic starting on Sunday March 21st from 2:30 to 3:30 p.m. I hope to offer this every Sunday at this time depending on participation. The cost is \$10 per session. A different area of the game will be covered each week with some occasional on course instruction.

Senior Monthly – Wednesday the 10th – 9 a.m. shotgun start

Men's Monthly – Saturday the 20th – 9 a.m. shotgun start – Format to be announced

Men's Match Play Tournament – Begins March 26th and runs until May 16th – You will have two weeks to complete each round of matches. 80% of handicap will be used and the entry fee is \$30.

Thursday Afternoon Scrambles start up again on March 18th. Call by 4:30 of each Thursday to sign up and we'll shotgun start by 5:15 to try to get done before dark. The way this works is; we'll alternate which nine that's played each week with the other nine still open for regular play. Both par 3s are played in a true scramble format and the format for the other seven holes will vary from week to week. Most of the holes will be played by choosing the best drive and then everyone playing their own ball in from there using handicaps and counting the two low net scores. The cost is \$20 and guests are welcome for an additional \$10. Open to anyone 16 years old and up. Come join in on this great weekly social event!

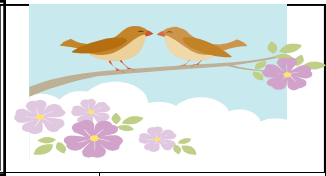
