

SUMMER SOCIAL GOLF PLAN

We here at Altadena Valley Country Club, would like to thank you for joining our club and we welcome you to our family of members. As a social member there are some different aspects associated with your membership and we would like to take just a moment to explain these. As a Social member you have full access to all facets of the club with exception to the golf facilities. You are welcome to use the golf facilities, but there are some restrictions and fees associated.

1. The practice facilities are not included in your membership. The cost is \$8 per person per hour. That includes the driving range, chipping green, and practice putting green. Proper attire is required at all times. See below.
2. Your Social/Summer Membership allows you to play three (3) rounds at a discounted greens fee. If you play more than the three rounds per month then you will be charged the regular greens fee and the associated cart fee.

The Golf Course Fees

Social/Summer Members Fees (For first 3 rounds per month)

18 Years of age & Over:

9 hole cart fee: \$ 8
9 hole greens fee: (walking) \$13
9 hole greens fee with cart: \$21

18 hole cart fee: \$15
18 hole greens fee: (walking) \$25
18 hole greens fee with cart: \$40

Juniors 17 years old and younger are:

9 hole greens fee: \$ 5
18 hole greens fee: \$10

Regular Greens Fees (Any rounds over the 3 per month)

18 Years of age & Over:

9 hole cart fee: \$ 8
9 hole greens fee: (walking) \$20
9 hole greens fee with cart: \$28

18 hole cart fee: \$15
18 hole greens fee: (walking) \$40
18 hole greens fee with cart: \$55

Juniors 17 years old and younger are:

9 hole greens fee: \$ 8
18 hole greens fee: \$15

Children under the age of 16 are able to ride for free with their parent but if they are 16 years or older they pay the associated cart fee.

Other rules regarding the golf course are:

1. The proper attire for the golf course and practice facilities is no denim, cut-offs, or athletic shorts. A collared shirt or a mock turtleneck shirt is required. No t-shirts. If you do not have golf shoes then tennis shoes are acceptable, but no metal cleats.
2. Children 16 and under are not allowed on the course until after 1 p.m. on Saturdays and Holidays.
3. Children under the age of 16 must play in groups of three (3) or smaller.
